



How to apply for permission to conduct organized activities in Dovrefjell-Sunndalsfjella National Park, Hjerkinns Protected Landscape and Knutshø Protected Landscape

From 2024, a permit is required for organized activities in Dovrefjell-Sunndalsfjella National Park, Hjerkinns Protected Landscape and partially in Knutshø Protected Landscape. This applies to both summer and winter activities.

"Activities are considered organized when an organizer (e.g., as a company, individual, team, school, or organization) plans, coordinates, or arranges trips with participants, and there is typically some form of announcement or registration involved (e.g. announcement/registration is not required for the activity to be considered as organized). If it is unclear whether the activity is an organized activity, emphasis can be placed on whether the activity involves a significant number of people or is repeated."

The requirements to apply also apply to school classes, tourist associations, volunteer groups and organizations, workshops, bird dog trials and similar activities. The list is not exhaustive.

Transport of equipment and tourists into the National Park by dog sled is subject to application requirements in the winter guiding area as well as the rest of the area.

Camping as part of the organized activity requires a permit and must be specified in the application. For camping in winter, a designated tent site in the winter guiding area will be continued.

Organized use of horse also requires a permit.

The following information is necessary for us to process the applications:

All items listed below must be completed; otherwise, the application will be returned

- **Name of company/organization:**
- **Responsible contact person:**
- **Trip period(s)**
Specify the date(s) for each trip or activity
- **Total number of guided days**
Estimate the total number of guided days.
Example: One day with one group and two guides = two days

- **Max no. of participants in the group (including guides)**
not the average, but the maximum number of participants
- **Number of overnight stays outdoors:**
during the period you are applying for
- **Activity/mode of travel:**
on foot (e.g. skiing, snowshoeing, hiking etc), dog sledding, organized horseback riding etc.
- **Describe activity:**
What is the purpose of the trip(s)?
E.g. Musk ox guiding, photography, summit tour, tent tour, DNT group. The list is not exhaustive
- **If dog sledding or organized horseback riding:**
 - Specify the maximum number of dog teams or horse equipages per trip
 - Enter the maximum number of dogs per team
- **Start location:**
List all starting points
- Attach a **map** with **description** showing the trips (on foot, organized horse riding, with dog teams and/or where to camp).
- A list with **names of all the guides** must be attached to the application. If new names are added, a revised list is sent continuously.
